

## Frequently Asked Questions

### *How do I become a member of the parish?*

Our participation in the Orthodox Church begins at Baptism (Chrismation for some) and continues throughout our life. We are united with Christ through the mysteries of the Church and through our faithful offering of our entire selves to Jesus Christ. For this reason, our Archdiocese requires each parish to distinguish between voting members and non-voting members. A voting member is over 18 years of age, and submits a Pledge Card, committing a portion of time, talent and treasure to the Church. Keep in mind that this is only part of true membership in the Body of Christ, which involves living according to His word, within His holy Church.

### *Why should I commit to give a specific amount?*

Your confidential commitment to support Christ's Church will show the Priest and Parish Council what the faithful people of God have provided for the ministries of the Church in 2020, allowing them to better plan for the growth and ministries of our sacred and beloved Church.

### *What if I am unable to fulfill my stewardship commitment?*

During the course of a year, circumstances change. Your stewardship is valued by God because it is made out of your love for Him and His Church. Please do *not* be concerned if you are unable to meet your stewardship commitment – we are thankful you are a part of this parish!
