Frequently Asked Questions

How do I become a member of the parish?

Our participation in the Orthodox Church begins at Baptism (Chrismation for some) and continues throughout our life. We are united with Christ through the mysteries of the Church and through our faithful offering of our entire selves to Jesus Christ. For this reason, our Archdiocese requires each parish to distinguish between voting members and nonvoting members. A voting member is over 18 years of age, and submits a Pledge Card, committing a portion of time, talent and treasure to the Church. Keep in mind that this is only part of true membership in the Body of Christ, which involves living according to His word, within His holy Church.

Why should I commit to give a specific amount?

Your confidential commitment to support Christ's Church will show the Priest and Parish Council what the faithful people of God have provided for the ministries of the Church in 2025, allowing them to better plan for the growth and ministries of our beloved parish family.

What if I am unable to fulfill my stewardship commitment?

During the course of a year, our circumstances may change. Our stewardship is valued by God because it is made out of love for Him and His Church. Please do *not* be concerned if you are unable to meet your stewardship commitment – we are thankful you are a part of this parish!

Honouring the Gifts We Have been Given



The grace of God, which cleanses and sustains us, represents the abiding and ultimate gift of the Creator to His creatures. And, as the quote from St. Nektarios of Aegina, on the adjoining page, points out, this gift is dispensed through his Church, which is, itself, a gift. Indeed, the Church is a gift to each of us, and to all of us. Yet this gift is sustained, in turn, by our gifts, which we offer up in the name of Christ Who was given for us in the manger, and Who offered Himself up as the ultimate gift upon the Cross. Just as in the Eucharist, we offer God the bread and wine, to be transformed by His grace into the Body and Blood, so in our stewardship do we offer up the things that we have been given in this life for the greater glory of God's grace, and for the abundant and abiding work of His Church. At this time of year we ask ourselves what we will offer up to support the ministries of the Church. But we must also remember to give thanks for what we have been given. -Fr. William
